

Step-by-step Directions for Joining and Uploading Observations to the New National Pollinator Pathway Project on iNaturalist

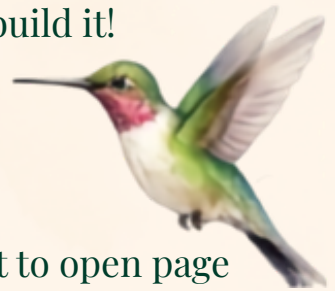


Why is this project important? Many iNaturalist projects are "collection projects:" they automatically collect observations that fit certain criteria, say from a geographical area or group of insects.

Our new National Pollinator Pathway project is a "traditional project:" it requires membership and a manual uploading of your sighting to the project. In this way, we can track and share what we are all seeing along the Pathway as we build it!

How to log observations for this project using a desktop computer:

- Visit inaturalist.org and sign up or log in
- Tap "Projects" in the toolbar, then "All Projects"
- Use the search bar to search for "National Pollinator Pathway," tap on it to open page
- On the top right corner of the page, tap "Join this project"
- Once you've uploaded an observation, tap the "Projects" search bar on that page to find the National Pollinator Pathway project. You'll see our name and butterfly icon appear on your project list - hurray!



How to log observations for this project on your phone:

- Download or open the iNaturalist app, choose the iNat Classic option
- Tap "Projects," search for National Pollinator Pathway, then choose to join the project
- Tap the Camera icon to Observe then choose "Camera" to take a picture or "Photo Library" to use a picture you have already taken
- Next, choose to Edit the observation, tap Projects, and tap the toggle for National Pollinator Pathway
- Your observation will be added to the National Pollinator Pathway project!
